

WCRLF Engages Corona Virus Fears

The Western Cape Religious Leaders Forum (WCRLF), meeting in Council at the Ahlul Bait Mosque in Ottery, Cape Town, on Thursday 12 March 2020, notes with grave concern the growing impact of the novel Corona Virus on the human population. The WCRLF strongly encourages communities of Faith throughout the Western Cape to heed the advice and guidelines provided by the National Department of Health, the National Institute for Communicable Diseases, and the World Health Organisation in seeking to contain the spread of the novel Corona Virus, while combating fear by continuing to draw on the gift of our belief systems and our trust in God.
